This year, Gallery Weekend Berlin will take place for the 16th time in a row. Founded as a private initiative of Berlin galleries, the event is driven, now more than ever, by a collaborative spirit and the joint efforts of the participating partners.

We are pleased that Gallery Weekend, as a decentralized event with local exhibitors, can take place amidst the current situation – in a slightly adapted format. The galleries are preparing a high-quality exhibition program, including younger positions such as Ambera Wellmann, Nora Kapfer, and Tamina Amadya, as well as established artists Thomas Schütte, Olafur Eliasson, Isa Genzken, Phillipe Parreno, Ugo Rondinone, Andreas Gursky, Miriam Cahn, Rosemary Mayer, Raimund Girke and Gotthard Graubner.

Gallery Weekend will expand digitally through September and beyond this year's programming: with the new website, Gallery Weekend aims to stay in touch with its visitors, keeping them informed on the exhibitions held in the galleries and reaching out to national and international guests, currently unable to make their way to Berlin. The website provides virtual introductions to the exhibitions on each of the galleries' individual pages and will be regularly updated to further function as a sales platform during Gallery Weekend. In addition, it offers a comprehensive overview of topics relevant to the Berlin art scene, highlighting the views of key figures within it as well as granting a historical review of the capital's art market. Contributions by numerous authors are in store – essays, studio visits, background stories, interviews, and films.
